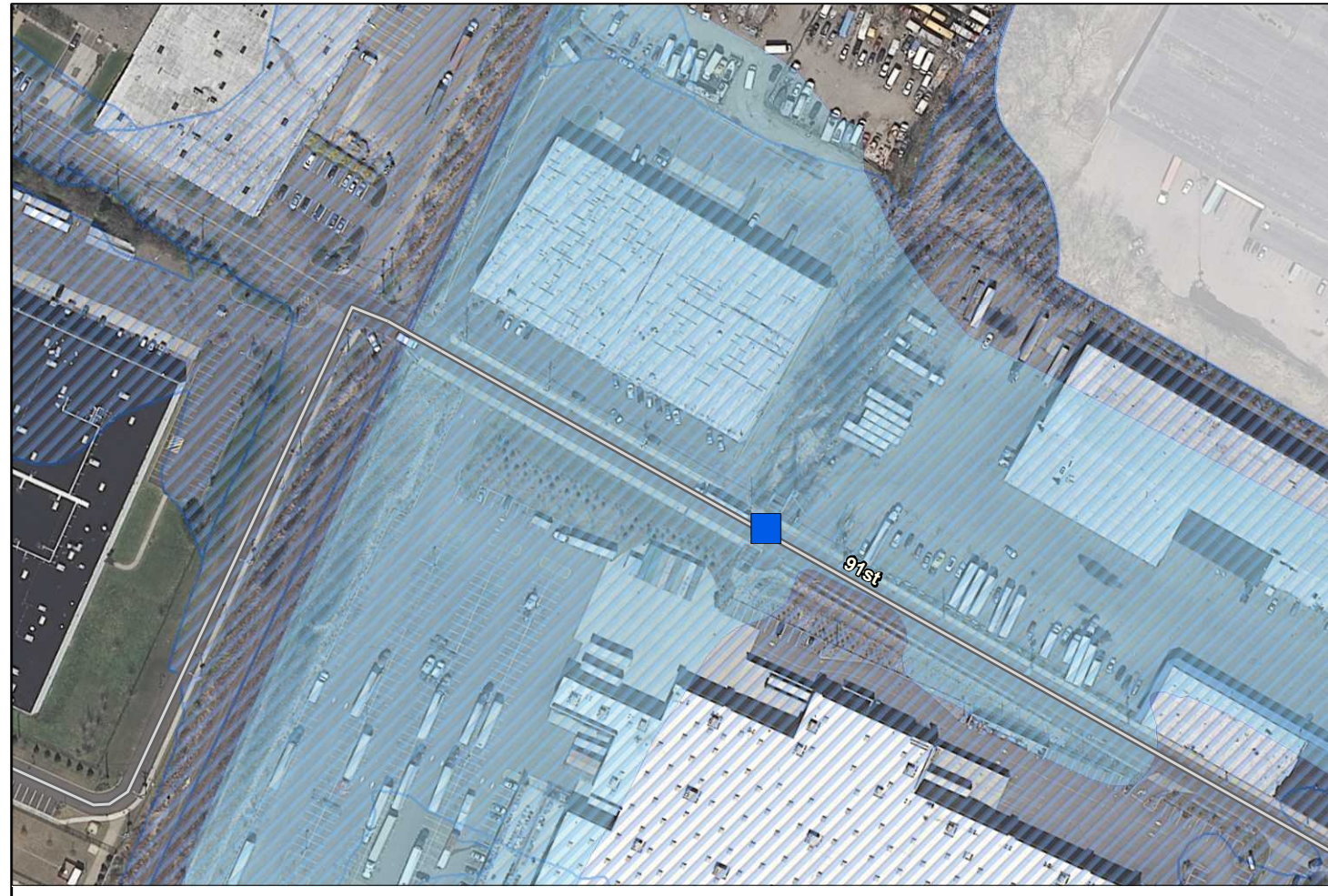
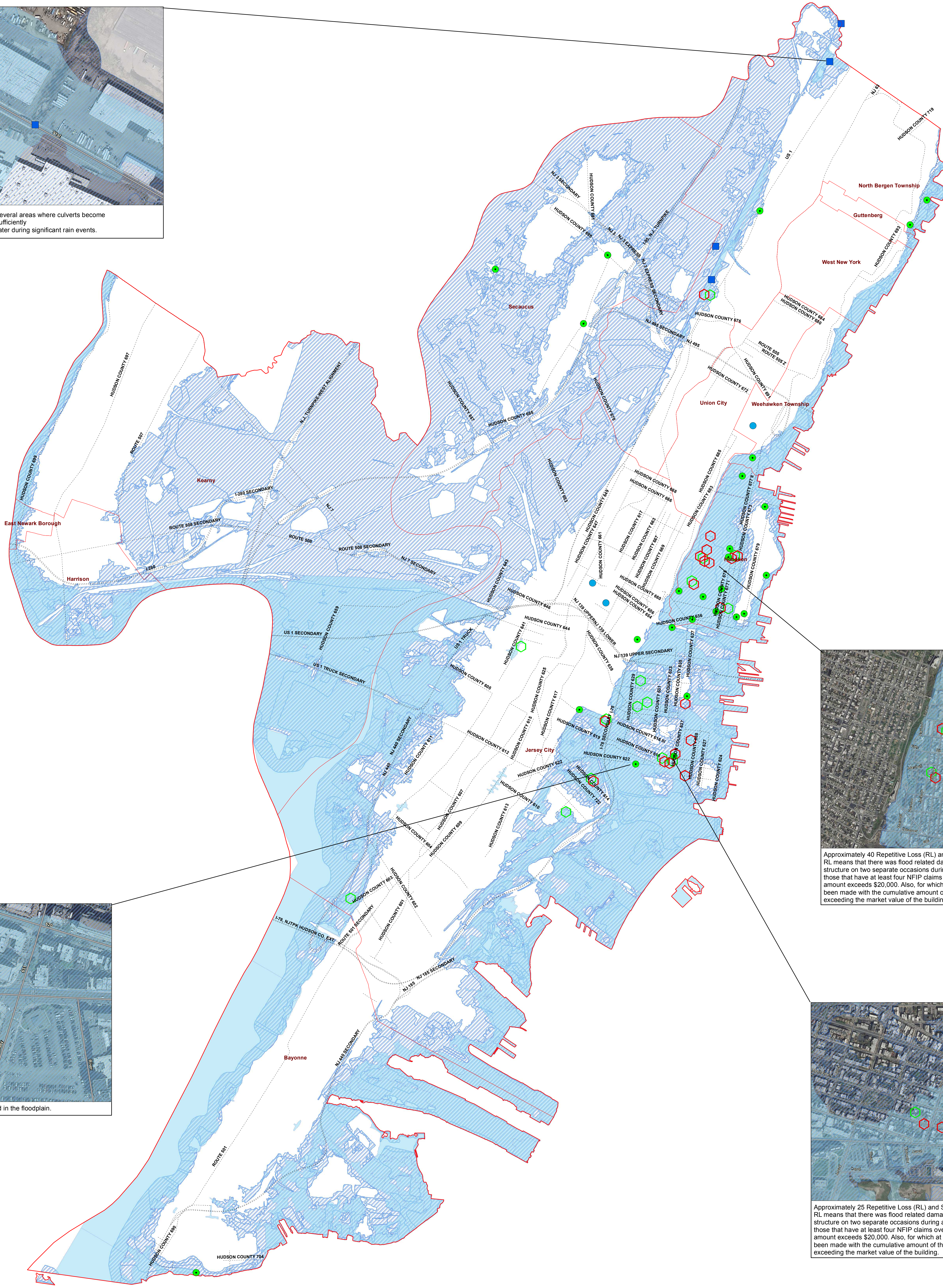


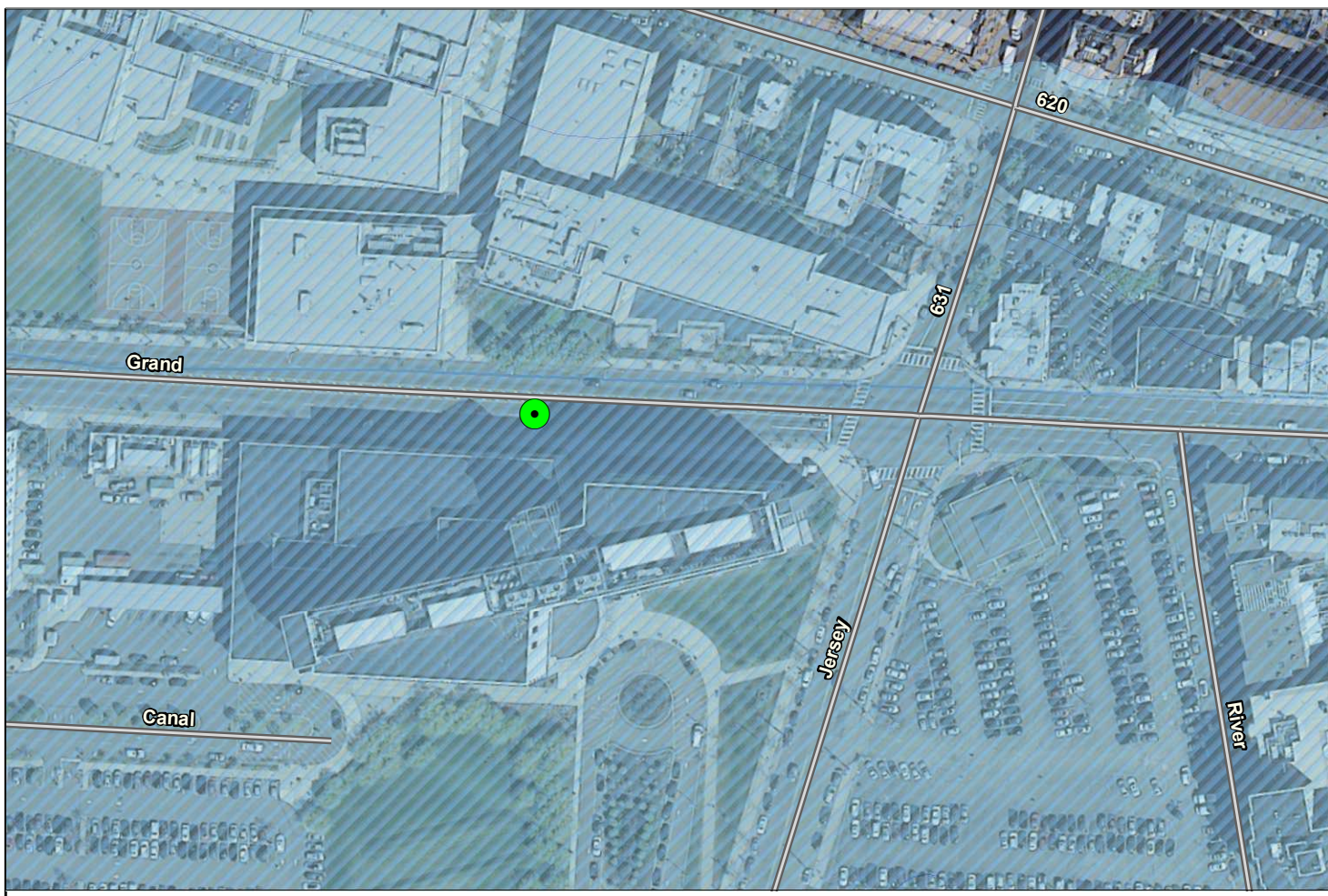
# Areas of Mitigation Interest DRAFT Hudson County, New Jersey



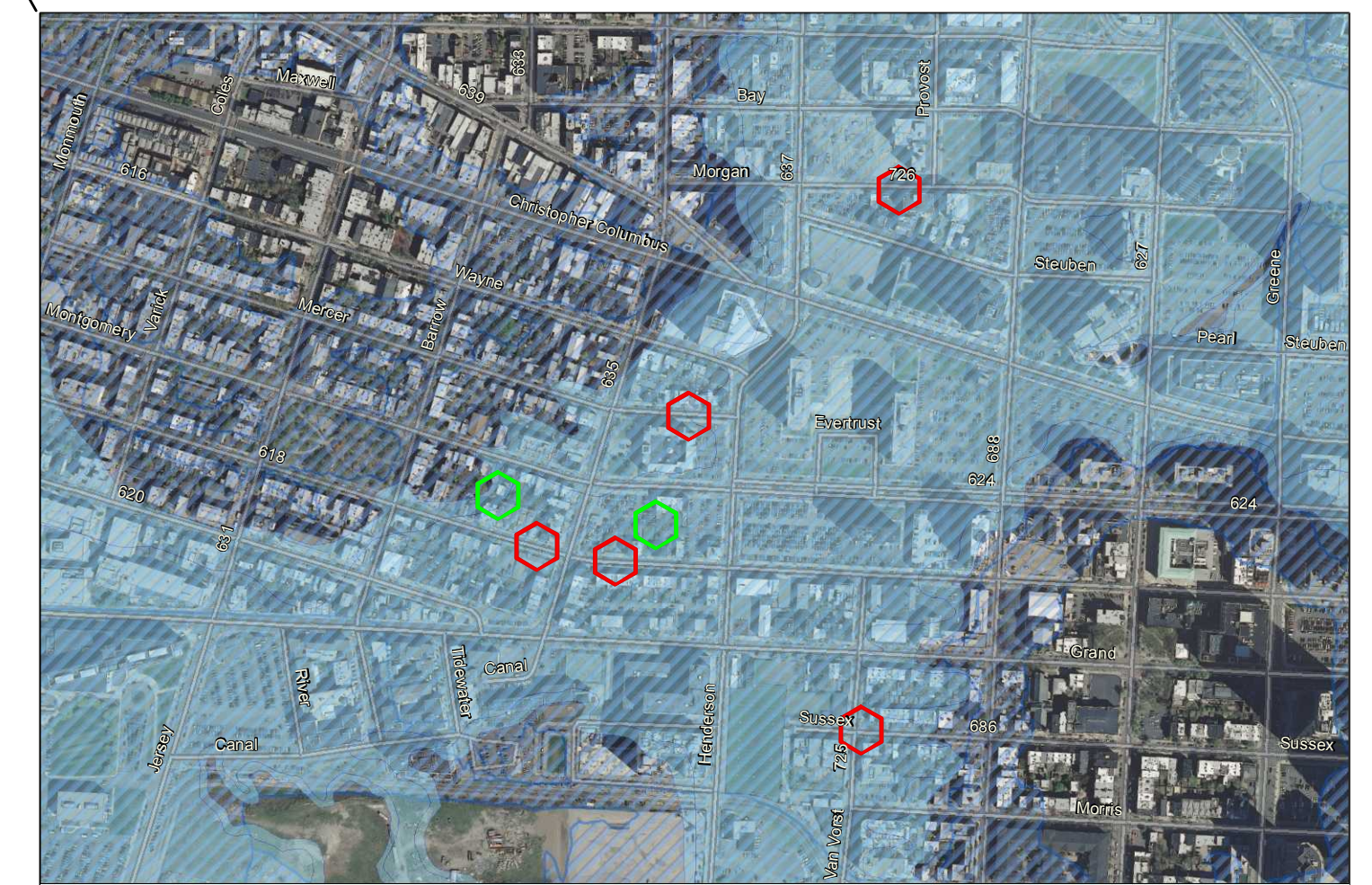
Along the Wolf Creek Tributary, there are several areas where culverts become clogged and flooded. The culverts are not sufficiently constructed to handle the amount of backwater during significant rain events.



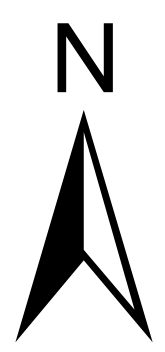
Approximately 40 Repetitive Loss (RL) and Severe Repetitive Loss (SRL) claims. RL means that there was flood related damage sustained by a structure on two separate occasions during a 10-year period. SRL properties are those that have at least four NFIP claims over \$5000 each, and the cumulative amount exceeds \$20,000. Also, for which at least two separate claims payments have been made with the cumulative amount of the building portion of such claims exceeding the market value of the building.



Jersey City Medical Center is an at risk essential facility located in the floodplain.



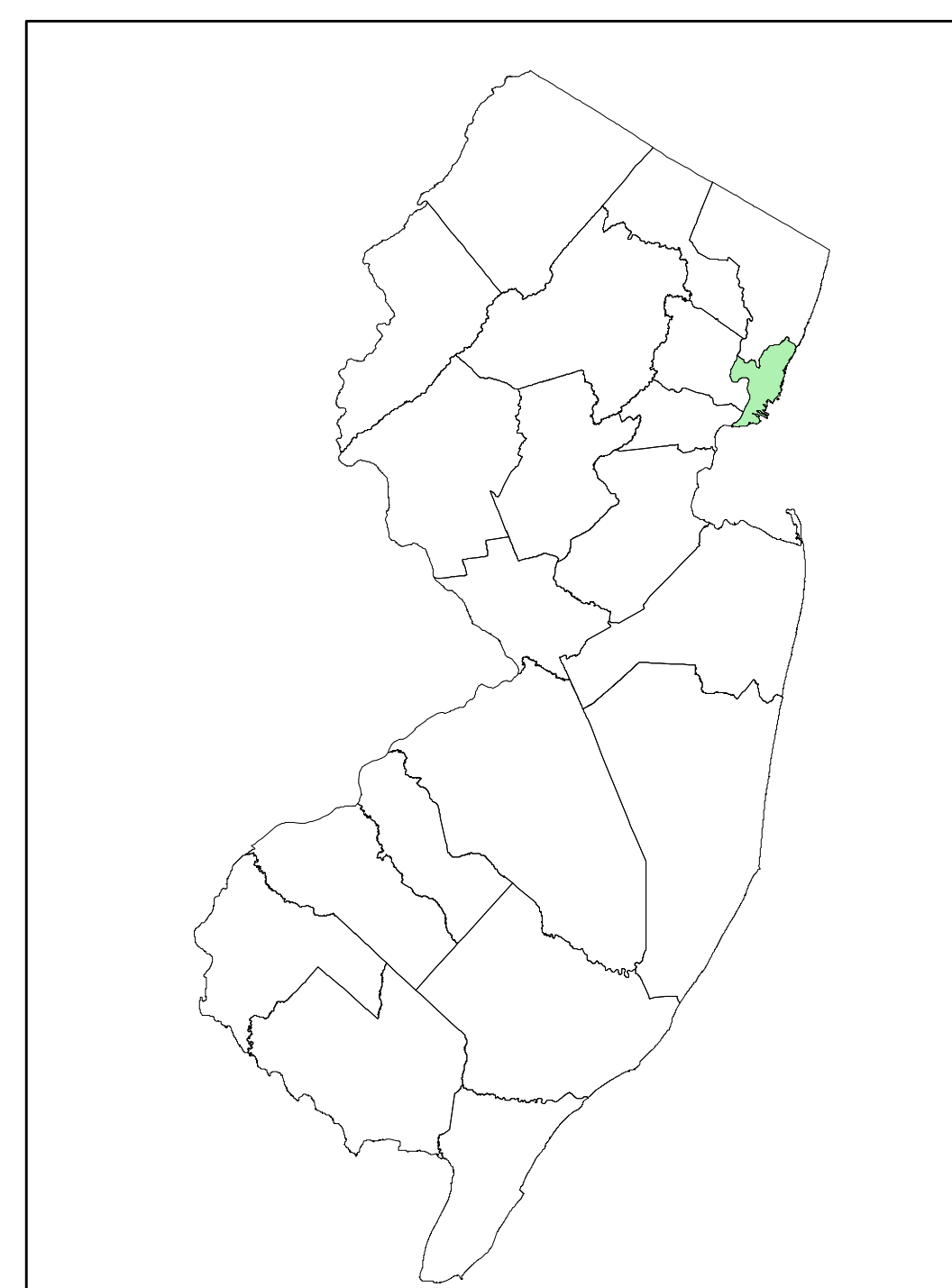
